The **health** and **well-being** of students, faculty, staff, and employers attending the **UCF Spring 2022 In-Person Career Expo** is our top priority. The university cannot guarantee a risk-free environment or an environment free of COVID-19 or other diseases. However, the following general precautionary measures will reduce the likelihood of contracting COVID-19 on campus. Therefore, all members of the university community and those who come to campus or participate in campus events (such as visitors, vendors, volunteers, and contractors) are asked to:

- Follow CDC guidelines regarding facial coverings. Consistent with these guidelines, we expect individuals to wear face coverings while indoors.
- Follow good hygiene guidance, such as regular hand washing (or use of hand sanitizer), avoiding touching your face, and disinfecting touched items.
- Engage in respiratory etiquette, including covering coughs and sneezes. Avoid sharing phones, desks, offices, or other work tools and equipment, as much as possible.
- Frequently sanitize shared tools and equipment, among other things, as well as clean touchpoints within office suites, departments, or worksites frequently.

No person should come to campus if they have tested positive for COVID-19, even if they are asymptomatic, until such time as they are cleared by a healthcare provider to return to normal activities.

No person should come to campus:

- if they are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or
- if unvaccinated, if any person living in the same residence has tested positive for COVID-19 or is sick with or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, or
- if unvaccinated, for the advised period after close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is ill with COVID-19 symptoms, or
- until released by a healthcare provider or a public health official after receiving a positive COVID-19 test result, even if asymptomatic, or
- for the period advised by a healthcare provider or public health official while waiting for COVID-19 test results.

In addition, following COVID-19 safety protocols will also be in place.

- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the arena during the Career Expo.
- Organizations are allowed a maximum of 4 representatives per table. Additional representatives beyond the 4-person limit will NOT be permitted.
- There will be one entrance and one exit with signs indicating a one-way flow for attendees.

- Every person attending the Career Expo, including employer representatives, will be required to sign-in the day of the event. Career Services is required to maintain a list of attendees for 60 days, to allow for contact tracing as needed.
- Shaking hands is discouraged.

UCF Career Services is not responsible for inherent risks involved with large public events (such as illness including but not limited to infectious disease such as a coronavirus). Individuals that have tested positive for COVID-19, even if they are asymptomatic, should not come to campus.
