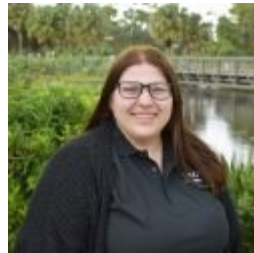
OUR MISSION

Requesting Events on Handshake

- Log in and click on **Events**

- Click **Request Event** to submit your event

All requests are reviewed by the Career Services team before being displayed to students. Once approved, you will receive a confirmation from Handshake. For on-campus events, you will receive a confirmation that includes details such as location, a campus map, and parking information.

On-Campus Interviews

Coordinate interviews for open positions within your organization by scheduling interviews right on campus! This benefits student by eliminating a common hurdle: **Transportation.**

Workshops

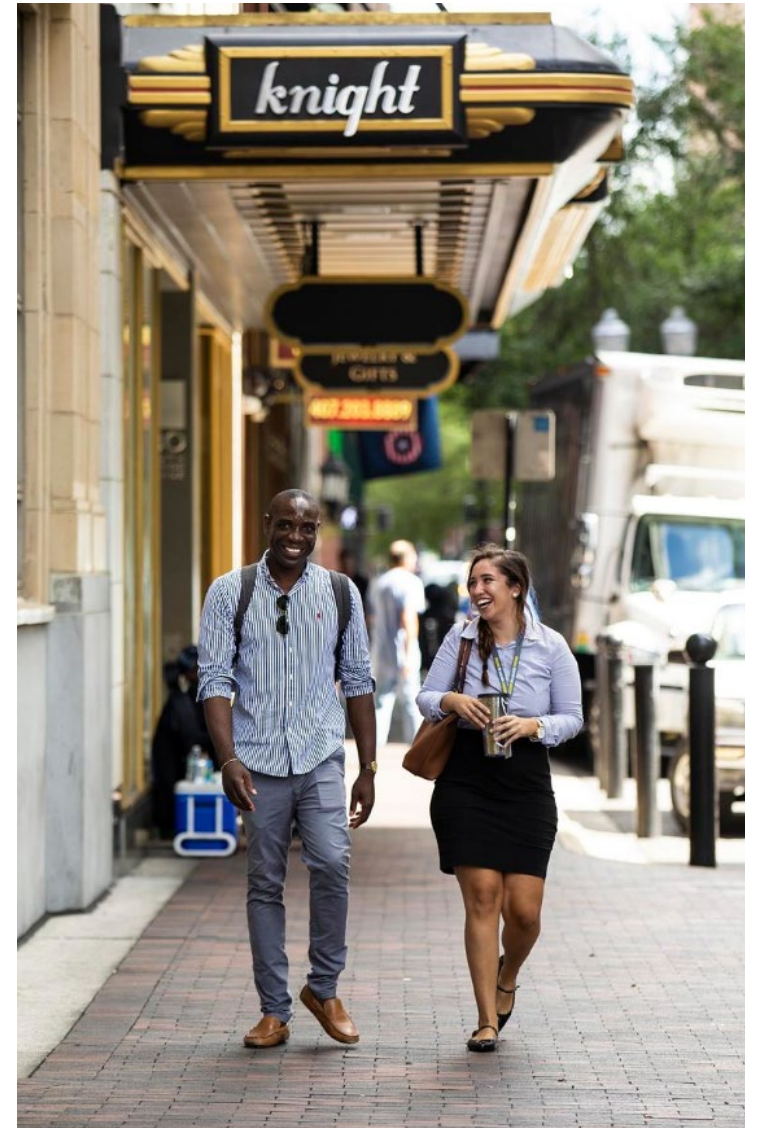
